 - Confirm entity-specific process and forecast for MOU signature



Goal and Purpose of MOU

- Goal: Execute the MOU this fall and attach to Final EIS
 - MOU is a non-binding agreement
- Purpose:
 - MOU signals support and areas of agreement to the Legislature
 - MOU can help move forward toward estuary restoration, for shared benefit
 - MOU is a bridging document to a future ILA
 - ILA will support a working waterfront and recreational boating in the Deschutes Estuary



MOU Open Items for Discussion

- Maximum increase to allocated costs?
 - If so, should costs in Attachment 1 be updated to include increase?
- New content to further increase certainty of funding through 2050
 - Reconvene to discuss approach if funds are exhausted before 2050
 - No lowering of annual payments
- Status of financial management role
- Trigger to begin annual payments
 - "Construction funding" rather than "full construction funding"
- Use of planning-level costs in the MOU
 - Ability to update costs if/as refined before annual payments begin
- Assumptions regarding Port Plaza and Percival Landing
- Agreement around Table 2?



Remaining Steps


- September 16: draft final MOU (v3) circulated
- September 22: FGWG meeting to discuss outstanding MOU content
- September 27: Final MOU sent to FGWG
- Early October: FGWG signature on final MOU
- End of October: Final EIS issued with signed MOU as attachment
- 2023: Begin work toward ILA


